

Exception: NWCT is an all day camp with a supervised lunch break. When registering your child, please note the specific age groups served. If you need help registering your child, we are available every weekday to assist you.

LOCATION:

The Sherwood Center for the Arts is located in historic Old Town—a safe, walkable, vibrant neighborhood in the heart of Sherwood. We are across the street from family-friendly Cannery Square, and kitty-corner to the Sherwood Library.
